Entry Fees: \$20 for one piece, \$30 for two, \$35 for three. Check or cash only. If paying with cash, please bring the exact amount as change will not be available.

Receiving Dates: Deliver entries on Sunday, October 6, 12pm to 3pm, and Monday, October 7, 10am to 1pm. If you are unable to drop off artwork on these dates, please email show chairs in advance to make other arrangements.

Show opens: October 9, 2024

Reception: Friday, October 11, 5-8 pm. Coincides with 2nd Friday Art Walk.

Pick Up: Show closes November 2. Artwork should be picked up on Sunday, November 3, 12pm to 3pm, or Monday, November 4, 10am to 1pm. If you need to make different arrangements, contact shows@msartists.org

Eligibility: Open to all current MSA members. Members are invited to submit up to three of their original works. Members with a "volunteer" membership should be volunteering on a regular basis.

Requirements: Artwork must follow the Specifications for Exhibited Artwork shown on MSA website.

- 1. No item should be removed by the artist before the show closes.
- 2. MSA gallery receives 30% of the sale price from sold works.
- 3. Reproductions of completed artwork are not accepted. (This does not apply to photographic or digital artwork)
- 4. Artwork must be identified on the back in a secure manner with the artist's name, contact information and title of the work.
