Artists are invited to submit all types of clay, pottery and ceramic artwork.

Open to all artists, age 18 and over. Note: all accepted artwork must be hand-delivered to the Marin Society of Artists (no shipping or mailing).

You may submit digital images of up to six (6) of your original works, not previously shown in a Marin Society of Artists juried exhibition. Only online entries with digitally uploaded images will be accepted. Digital entries must be RECEIVED via online application before midnight, August 25. Notification will be by email of accepted and non-accepted work.

FEES

A non-refundable entry fee will be charged. Maximum of six pieces per artist. **Entry fee for Non-members**: \$25 for one piece; \$35 for two pieces; \$5 each additional piece up to a maximum of six.

Entry fee for Marin Society of Artists members: \$20 for one piece; \$30 for two pieces; \$5 for each additional piece up to a maximum of six.

Artists should consider including two or more views for each artwork submitted [follow the instructions on Entrythingy on how to add *views* not pieces]. Fees to be paid by credit/debit card through PayPal [you do **not** need a PayPal account] or by PayPal transfer, during the digital entry process. E-checks are not accepted. Fee payment does not guarantee that any/all artworks submitted for jurying will be included in this exhibition.

SIZE LIMITATION

Artwork should not exceed 48"x 48 x 48"; and cannot exceed 50 pounds. Waivers can be requested and may or may not be granted. Email shows@msartists.org to request a waiver BEFORE entering show. See "Artwork Specifications" for additional requirements.

ENTRY PROCEDURE AND DIGITAL IMAGE FORMAT

Digital entries ONLY. To enter, go to https://www.marinsocietyofartists.org FOR ARTISTS and click on WORLD OF CERAMICS. From this page you can link to "Specifications for Exhibited Artwork", printable "Prospectus" and the link to enter the show.

Show entry is through **EntryThingy**. If you have already registered with **EntryThingy**, you may use your existing username and password to enter this show. NOTE: technical help will only be available until 5 PM PDT on August 24. Do not contact EntryThingy. They will not be able to help you.

Artists should consider including two or more views for each artwork submitted. Follow the instructions on Entrythingy on how to add *views* not pieces.

Please adhere to the following requirements for size of digital images:

Format: JPG. PNG or GIF

Resolution: 72 dpi with minimum 800 pixels and maximum 2000 pixels on the longest side

Size: Minimum 100KB; Not to exceed 5.0 MB for each image submitted

ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS

All accepted art must conform to "Specifications for Exhibited Artwork" available on our web site. Artwork that is to be wall hung must have a hanging wire. Any work that does not meet these criteria will not be displayed in the exhibition. All properly prepared entries will be viewed and judged. The decision of the juror is final.

ACCEPTED ARTWORK

The juror will accept no more than two works by each artist. Notification of accepted and non-accepted work will be made by email from alerts@entrythingy.com. Accepted artwork will also be posted online - check our website at www.msartists.org

Artwork must closely represent the quality of the digital images for showing in the exhibition. If the submitted image of your work diverges significantly from what the work looks like in color, shape, dimensions, etc., we reserve the right to not display the artwork.

Only original artwork juried into the show will be accepted - *no substitutions*. Artwork for wall installation must be fitted with hanging wire or similar hanging devices – no work may be fixed to the walls with screws, nails, or glue. Marin Society of Artists reserves the right not to display accepted work that arrives in non-display condition (wet paint, dirty, damaged, coming out of the frame, over size limits, or otherwise not ready for display). PLEASE review "Specifications for Exhibited Artwork" available on our website.

All artwork is to remain on display for the duration of the exhibition. NOTE: No changes to title or price will be permitted after jurying. Your entry into the exhibition will constitute your consent to the possible use of your images for advertising and promoting the exhibition. The Marin Society of Artists reserves the right to appoint a different juror if the current juror becomes unavailable.

ARTWORK DELIVERY

Accepted artwork should be delivered to the Marin Society of Artists, 1515 3rd Street, San Rafael on the following days and times:

Sunday, September 8, 12pm to 3pm, or

Monday, September 9, 10am to 1pm

Note: no shipping or mailing artwork to MSA, all work must be hand delivered.

REMOVAL OF ARTWORK

The pickup dates for unsold artwork are:

Sunday, October 6 from 12pm to 3pm, and

Monday October 7 from 10am to 1pm.

Marin Society of Artists will not be responsible for artwork left after the pickup dates unless arrangements have been made with the show chairperson. Artwork left beyond 15 days without prior arrangement will be considered a donation to Marin Society of Artists and Marin Society of Artists may dispose of in any way it sees fit.

SALES

By submitting work for exhibit, the Exhibitor authorizes Marin Society of Artists to sell such work for the "Show Price" indicated for each work on the entry form. After a sale occurs, Marin Society of Artists will reimburse the exhibitor an amount equal to the "Show Price" less 30%. Enter NFS in "Show Price" for work that is not for sale.

LIABILITY

Marin Society of Artists, its officers, directors, employees, and/or volunteers will not be responsible for loss or damage to artwork, however caused. Marin Society of Artists suggests that participants carry separate insurance. Entry into the exhibition constitutes agreement with this understanding.
